William C. Ransom,

93, of Indianapolis, passed away March 13, 2015, and has joined his wife, Ida Kathleen (Kathy) of 63 years who preceded him in death, in heaven. He's much happier now being reunited with her for eternity. Bill was born in West Virginia in 1921, but spent most of his adult life in Indiana.

Bill served honorably in the U.S. Army in WW II, from 1942-1944, returning to Huntington, West Virginia where he met his bride Kathy, literally sweeping her off her feet and into his arms. They moved to Indiana in 1947, first to Gas City, then settling in Indianapolis, living here for over 60 years. He worked at MacAllister Machinery for 48 years, retiring in 2000, at the age of 79.

Bill is survived by his son, Michael (Crisanta); two grandsons; Evan (Nicole) Ransom and Elliot (Kathleen) Ransom; and two great-granddaughters, Vivienne and Julia; two brothers, George and Jim (Mary Jo); and one sister, Elizabeth Hargis.
