



## William B. Ulmer

December 6, 1937 - July 1, 2014

76, of Indianapolis, passed away July 1, 2014. He was born December 6, 1937 to the late Ivan and Gladys Ulmer. William was a graduate of Thomas Carr Howe High School. He graduated from the University of Cincinnati where he was a member of Sigma Chi Fraternity, and a "Life Loyal Sig". He served his country in the U.S. Air Force during the Cuban Call Up from 1962-1963. Bill retired in 1993 after 37 years as an architect with Eli Lilly & Co., during which time he initiated the Co-Op Education Program, instituted contractor safety practices and developed usage of minority businesses.

Bill was a member of AIA, licensed architect in both Indiana and Arizona, an active and competitive tennis player receiving many national awards, and was also a co-chairperson of the Stadium Committee RCA Tennis Championships.
